Agriculture in the Northern Cape

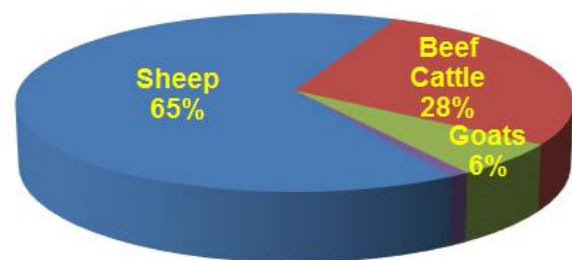
- Next to mining agriculture is the second most important productive economic sector in the province.
- Development in agriculture strives to:
 - Ensure sustainable resource management
 - Improve global competitiveness and profitability
 - Enhance equitable access and participation
- The potential arable land is less than 1% of the total land area.
- Crop production occurs mainly on the banks of the Vaal, Harts and Orange rivers.
- More than 70% of the total land is utilized as extensive natural grazing for stock farming and nature conservation game farming accounts for 11%.

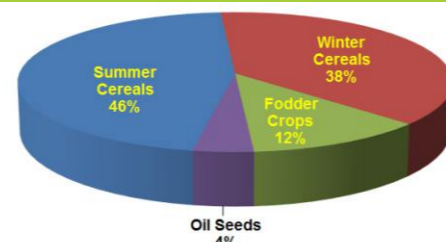
NC: MAJOR LIVESTOCK PRODUCTION

- Livestock Production accounts for over 70% of land use



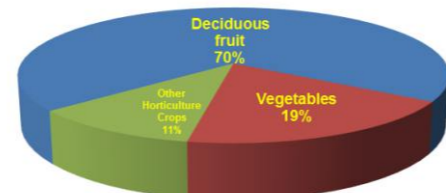
Field Crops

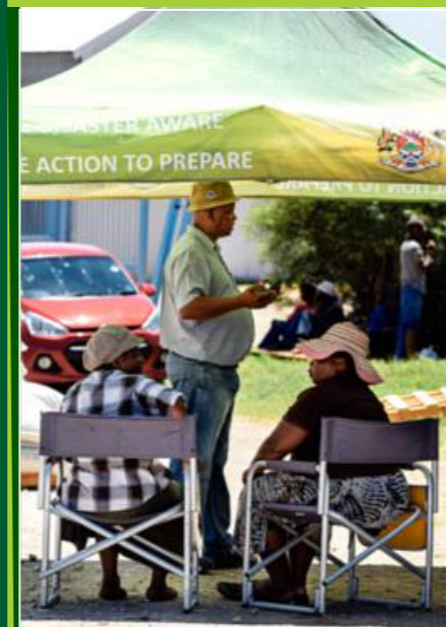

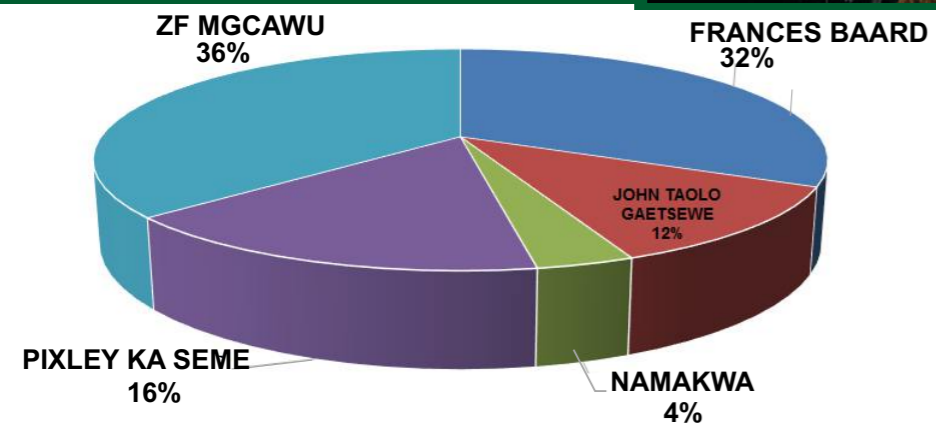
